

Prepare how you will engage with customers- Plan an open ended question that will stimulate conversation.

Prepare 3-4 questions – A big key to success in working a booth is knowing who are canadates- and

Do it quickly. You need to ensure you spend time with people who are interested in what you are selling.

Make a great first Impression-People decide when they are 30 feet away wheather or not they are going to stop and talk to you. Make sure your body language is saying "please stop and learn about my business!"

Create a follow-up plan and follow up fast-The longer you wait, the longer the customer has to forget about you. Have a plan in place to follow up, Show sales and earn long term customers.















