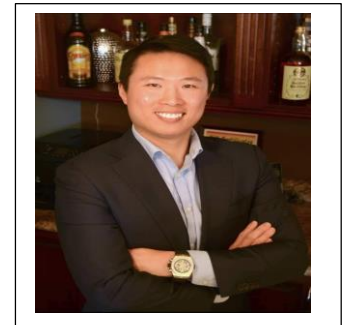

Local Economic Stimulus

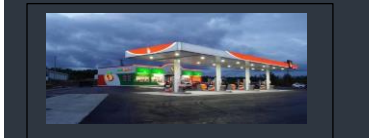
